Chief Carpenter's Corner

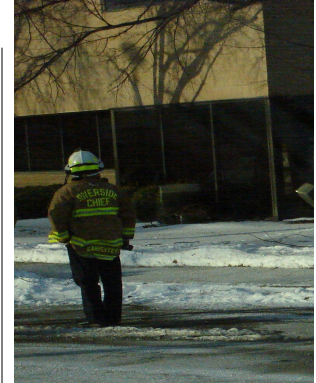
As we enter into the holiday season; we will publish a combined November/December Newsletter.

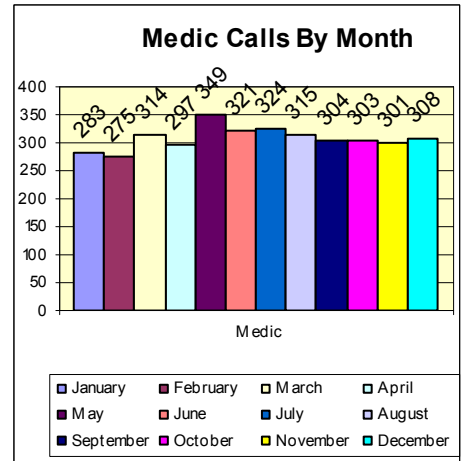
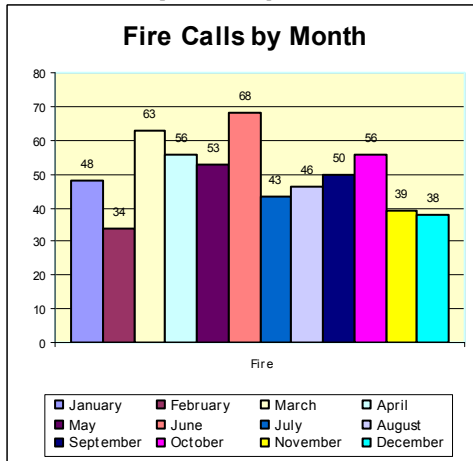
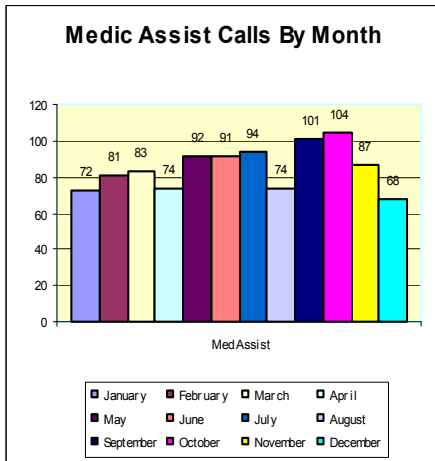
